#### New York State Assessments:

To earn a New York State Regents Diploma graduates must satisfy 5 required Regents exams with a score of 65 or better as follows: ELA, 1 Math, 1 Science, 1 Social Studies, and 1 Pathway Assessment.

To earn a New York State Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation graduates must satisfy 8 required Regents exams with a score of 65 or better in one of the two following combinations ... *Traditional Combination*: ELA, 3 Math, 2 Science, and 2 Social Studies or *Pathway Combination*: ELA, 3 mathematics, 1 social studies, 2 science (1 must be life science and 1 must be physical science), 1 Pathway (other than science or mathematics).
